Certified Observers are a key and valuable part of the Los Sueños Tournaments. To qualify you need to be certified by the IGFTO, IGFA or by the Los Sueños Observer Certification Program (LSOCP) and submit the Observer application form. Observers are selected on their fishing experience and by their physical ability to be stationed in the cockpit, near the action.

TUESDAY | January 15th

5 am - 5:45 am Observer assignments are handed out at the Hook Up. Breakfast includes eggs, gallo pinto (rice and beans), pastries, fresh fruit, coffee and juice provided for Observers. Observers must be on boats by 5:45 am at the latest.

6 am Boats may leave the Marina and Herradura Bay at 6:00 am as soon as the assigned Observer is on board.

8 am - 4 pm Lines In - Lines Out. Lunch is provided by the boat.

7 pm or sooner Scorecards must be in to Tournament Committee at the Tournament Lawn

WEDNESDAY | January 16th

4 pm - 7 pm Ladies Only Tournament Observers are invited to attend the awards presentation to be held on the Tournament Lawn next to the Hook Up. Dockside cocktail and heavy hors d'oeuvres are served. The Awards are followed by the mandatory tournament meeting for the first leg of the 2019 Los Sueños Signature Triple Crown.
